

Topical Collection call for papers

Dear participants of the 14th International Workshop on Wave Hindcasting and Forecasting and 5th Coastal Hazards Symposium and the 2nd JCOMM Scientific and Technical Symposium on Storm Surges.

As announced during the workshop, we would like to invite you to submit your work to a topical collection in *Ocean Dynamics*. The guest editors will be Val Swail (Environment Canada), Jose-Henrique Alves (NCEP/NOAA), Diana Greenslade (Bureau of Meteorology, Australia), Kevin Horsburgh (National Oceanography Centre, UK) and Oyvind Breivik (MET Norway).

Submissions should stick to the main topics of the workshop, but need not necessarily have been presented at the workshop. We welcome you and other workers in the field to submit your abstract to the editors by 1 December 2015. We will consider whether it is relevant for publication and respond back by 15 December. We set the deadline for paper submissions to 1 February 2016. To ensure that papers will be published at roughly the same time it is important to stick to these deadlines.
